- Mobile medical clinics to remote communities
- Health based youth empowerment programs

NICARAGUA

Project Limón

- FIMRC's clinic offers care to patients of all ages, with specialty care for women and children
- Therapy program for youth with disabilities
- Prenatal and postnatal home visits
- Diabetes and hypertension support groups

EL SALVADOR

Project Las Delicias

- FIMRC's clinic provides care to patients of all ages
- Family planning program for adolescents
- Water sanitation program
- Zika & preventative health education efforts

COSTA RICA

Project Alajuelita

- FIMRC clinic provides primary care and psychological services to patients of all ages, including refugees
- Mobile medical clinics for remote communities
- Expressive therapy and health education sessions given in waiting room, on outreach, and with local partners

- Support local hospitals and government health posts

- Portawawa prenatal program and holistic support groups for women and teen mothers

- Well-child visits in local crèches (day care centers)
- Physical therapy support provided to local school
- Chimney installation program
- FIMRC rural clinic provides primary care to patients including specialty services for women's health

- Health-based youth empowerment programs
- Home health visits with local health post physicians
- Nutrition programming for underweight children

PERU

Project Bududa

- FIMRC clinic, equipped with a maternity ward and full lab, provides primary care services, HIV testing and counseling, malaria testing, and more
- Health education and outreach programs with FIMRC's local Community Health Educators (CHEs)

Project Cavite

- PhilPEN chronic disease screenings with local barangay health workers
- Psychosocial therapy through arts and crafts with children at UP Cancer Institute
- Youth health clubs to encourage healthy habits
