Advocacy & Awareness: Project Limón, Nicaragua

Los Pipitos Therapy Program

Overview: Although tourism has been on the rise in Nicaragua, the community of Limón is still left behind in terms of access to health care and resources. Quite often, families and children with disabilities are even more so left behind which creates even greater barriers for these children to lead full and productive lives. The Los Pipitos Developmental Program provides support to children with disabilities as well as their families through physical therapy sessions. This allows the children to receive high quality care and individualized attention dependent on the child's needs.
